Mary Spraull called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

CORRESPONDENCE: Special Use Permit application from Mike Klemish on the removal of sand from McConnell Court.

Tom York made a motion to accept the minutes as written from March 8, 2013. Mike Spitnale seconded the motion.

Tom York made a motion to open the Public Hearing for Mike Klemish. Laura Dawson seconded the motion. All in favor.

PUBLIC HEARING: Mary Spraull called the Public Hearing to order at 7:05 pm Mike Klemish gave the Planning Commission information on his intent to remove apx 1.37 acres of sand from his property at the end of McConnell Court. (100-015-100-260-00.) He asked for a 50ft set back. He would be selling the sand to an excavating company. He stated he has 3 parcels each one is: 5 acres, 10 acres and 15 acres. For a total of 30 acres. He stated he has filed paper work, with the Township to combine them into one parcel. He said he had the required permit from the County. (A pond over 1 acre requires a permit from Midland County.) This Special Use falls into Section 7.12 in the current Zoning Ordinance. Mining, Quarrying, Gravel Processing and Earth Removal (Special Use). After he gave his information, the public had time to share their thoughts.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Only one township resident said they didn't have a problem with it.

Mary Spraull made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Tom York seconded the motion. All in favor. Public Hearing was closed at 7:45pm Mary Spraull made a motion to Re-Enter the Regular Meeting. Tom York seconded the motion. Mary Spraull re-opened the regular meeting at 7:46pm

TOPIC OF DISCUSSION: The Planning Commission discussed their thoughts with each other. The verbiage in Section 7.12 was studied. He would need a Bond to cover bringing the road used to enter/exit from his property back to working condition. The Zoning Ordinance requires 150 ft. setback from property lines. He requested 50ft.

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After the Planning Commission had their discussion, Tom York made a motion to vote individually on the Special Use Permit for 1.37 acres of Sand Removal for Mike Klemish. Mike Spitnale seconded the motion.
