Information on fire equipment grants and Midland Tomorrow grants were looked at. Also we will work on the Loon Baseball project in December.

George is still working on the gas line to the hall. Solar panels cost about \$80,000 (40,000 for the panels, 16,000 for the batteries, 24,000 for the electrical equipment). Wanda will call Mr LaVere about the geothermic. Darla will contact Rosebush for their input on costs. Darla will also research wind energy.

Doris will write the Midland Daily News about the money received from the Midland Foundation.

We discussed the possibility of having a cell tower on township property. She will see if there is an interest. If so, the proceeds could go toward hall building and maintenance.

The next meeting is May 27, 2014.

A motion to adjourn was made by Wanda and seconded by Tom. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
